Literacy	Read your favourite book with an adult. Tell an adult about your favourite part.	Read a book with an adult. Play 'I Spy' looking for the letters in the alphabet you know.	Look at just the pictures in a story (a picture walk) before reading it. Talk about what you think the story will be about.	Read a book with a stuffed animal. Draw a picture of the setting. (The setting is where the story takes place.)
Numeracy	Look around your home for objects that are squares and circles. Draw a picture of four objects you find. What is the difference between a square and a circle?	Jump as you count to 10. Touch your toes as you count to 20.	Print the numbers 0 to 10 in your best printing. Remember to start your numbers at the top. Circle the number that shows your age.	Pour a small amount of cereal in a bowl. Count out 20 pieces. Put them back in the bowl and try counting out a teen number. Repeat.
Play	Play 'I Spy' with a family member.	Play Simon Says with a family member.	Play 'What Time Is It Mr. Wolf?' with family members.	Build the tallest tower you can with household items or toys. How tall is it? Is it taller than you? Is it shorter than someone at home?
Other Ideas	Help a family member with a chore.	Practice tying your shoes independently.	Say out loud Nursery Rhymes like Humpty Dumpty, Little Miss Muffet, Jack and Jill etc. and look for the rhyming words.	Do a puzzle and draw a picture of the puzzle when it is finished.
