<b>Play</b>	Have fun playing with your toys. Make up a story with your toys. Share your story with a family member.	Play a board game.	Fill the sink with water and bubbles and have fun playing in the water. Find objects that will sink and float.	Listen to and sing along to Peter Cottontail on YouTube and Boom Chicka Boom Easter Songs for Kids on YouTube.
