Literacy	Read one of the stories on starfall.com. Click on Grades 1,2,3 then click on Learn to Read. Choose a book to listen to from this section. You could also use Epic!	Jolly Phonics Mrs. Newman Qu,qu Miss Andreachuk Ww Look at the picture, say the letter name, say the sound and do the action.	If the weather is nice, go outside to read a story. Look for the letter you learned yesterday in the book.	Make some flashcards with any of the letters taught so far. Make 2 of each and play a memory game. Tell your grown up a word that begins with that letter when you pick up the card.
Numeracy	Make a 10 frame with paper and pencil. Remember 5 squares on top and 5 on the bottom. Have an adult print a number and you fill in the 10 frame with that many objects.	Try to count by 10s to 100. Use both hands to help. 10, 20, 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, 80, 90, 100	Make flashcards with the numbers 0 to 10. Make two cards of each number and play a memory game. When you pick up your two cards during your turn, tell an adult which number is bigger or are they equal?	Today we are learning about 3D shapes. The first shape is a cone. It looks like an ice cream cone, a party hat and a pylon. Please draw a cone! Can you make a 3D cone out of paper?
Play	Draw some people on a paper. If you have scissors cut them out and play with them. If not, draw them on a smaller paper and play with them.	Play restaurant with your family members. Remember to use your manners. Can you make a menu by drawing food items and labelling them with Kindergarten spelling?	Play Simon Says with your family. Remember, you only do the action if Simon Says!	Have some fun outdoors. How many sounds do you hear? How many colours do you see? How many things can you feel?
Other Ideas	Pick an item from home and do Show-&-Tell just like you do at school.	Talk about Reduce, Reuse and Recycle. Find and sort items at home that you can do each with.	Pretend to be a Police Officer. Give out kindness "tickets" to your family. Try to spell and write the word as best you can.	Play outside with a ball. If you do not have a ball, ask what you could use instead. Ex. teddy bear, rolled up socks, plastic plate for a frisbee.
